The Family Development Specialist is responsible for acting as a resource to assigned families, facilitating assessment of need, goals, helping to recognize barriers to stability, and assisting with the development of strategies for meeting families' needs and strengthening their support network. This position will also assist in providing parent education and family support activities using curriculum such as the Nurturing Parenting Program and TBRI® .
